Supporting Staff Safety

All staff will be orientated to the District's [Safe and Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan](#) and the schools' Communicable Disease Prevention Plan on Tuesday, September 7th.

All staff K-12 are required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools, and on school buses.

All staff K-12 will complete a Daily Health Check prior to attending school.

- All staff will be orientated to the District's Safe and Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan and the school's Communicable Disease Prevention Plan during the week of January 4-7, 2022
- All staff are required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in school, and on buses.
- All staff will complete a Daily Health Check prior to attending school and sign in at the office indicating as such as per the new regulations as of January 4, 2022
- On-going communication and providing SD73 Safe & Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan
- Frequent reminders and regular staff meeting agenda items
- Masks will be worn at all times in the school, stay home if sick, sanitize hands upon entering the school and frequently throughout the day
- Remind staff to respect others' personal space and to observe occupancy limits

Communication to Parents/Guardians

- Pinantan Elementary's Communicable Disease Prevention Plan will be communicated to parents and guardians prior to January 10, 2022. This includes posting a copy of the plan on the school's website.
- Information on the most current Daily Health Check for parents to complete at home with their child starting and based upon their child's return to school in January 2022.
- Parents will be informed of the K-12 Health Check App and encouraged to refer to it for any questions they may have
- Parents will be informed of the most current mask mandate which will be in effect as of January 4, 2022.

Supporting Student Safety

- All students will be orientated to the appropriate sections of the District's Safe and Healthy Facilities Communicable Disease Prevention Plan and the school's Communicable Disease Prevention Plan upon their return to school during the weeks of January 4-7 and January 10-14, 2022
- All students in Kindergarten through Gr. 7 are now required to wear non-medical masks indoors, in schools and on buses as of January 4, 2022 unless they have a medical exemption
- Students who need a non-medical masks can bring them from home or get them from the office or there classroom teacher
- All students will be spaced within the learning environment and for gathering and events where possible while also avoiding face to face interactions as much as possible
- Seating plans will be provided to the Principal by classroom teachers anytime there is a change to the plan
- School gatherings and events will be held virtually however if they must be held in-person, limit the number of people to no more than 50% of operating capacity
- At this time, no spectators or audience members are allowed at any school events or gatherings
- All extracurricular sports tournaments are currently on hold

Lockers

- Will be accessed and monitored for congestion, especially between classes
- Classes will take turns preparing at their lockers/cubbies at days end to avoid congestion

Traffic Flow

- Students will enter and exit the school through their outside classroom doors
- K/1/2 class enters and exits through the main door of the school while the 2/3/4 and 5/6/7 classes enter and exit through their classroom doors
- As we are one hallway we will teach students to walk to the right when in the hallway and when moving between classrooms or common spaces.
- Pylon/markings will be placed in the hallway to indicate movement direction
- Signage will be placed on outside doors and within the school as per current COVID -19 restrictions and protocols in keeping everyone at school safe

Visitors

- All visitors are required to complete a Daily Health Check prior to entering the school
- All visitors are required to wear a non-medical mask indoors, in the school
- All visitors enter through the main door by appointment with the Principal
- All volunteers are required to participate in training prior to working with students and staff in the school as required for the position of responsibility
- Meetings with individuals /groups will be held virtually if at all possible

Student Transportation on Buses

- We do not have students transported by bus to and from school, therefore a bus would only be used for extra-curricular or field trip type events. As such all students and staff would be required to wear masks, and students will be spaced accordingly

Food Services/Lunch

- Occasionally Hot Lunches are ordered for students and are individually packaged from the vendor and distributed accordingly by staff
- No sharing of food
- No food coming from home to be distributed to others in the school
